

The Word Becomes Flesh

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us... John 1:14

While Jesus was about the business of “fleshing out” the *Word of God* the Pharisees believed He was contradicting it and ultimately they condemned Him to death for blasphemy. Religion had so blinded them that they assumed someone fulfilling the scriptures would look more like themselves. Jesus challenged their perception when He said, *You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me but you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life* John 5:39-40. When we receive revelation it is an invitation to experience God in a more intimate and accurate way. If we miss the experience we gain a religious ideal but not transformation. The question we need to ask ourselves is do we reflect Him accurately or while cherishing the scriptures are we contradicting *the Word made flesh*?
