PASTORAL CALL UPDATE

We are slowly but surely moving forward on the road to calling our new Pastor. Council and Elders will be meeting on May 1st to form the Call Committee. They will prayerfully consider names from a list of Members over age 18, confirmed, and that have been in attendance in 2018. We will try to give you updates on a weekly basis, and as always, please feel free to bring your questions and concerns to an Elder, or a Council Member. In the meantime, here are some things that YOU can do to get ready for our new Pastor:

Pray. Prayer is essential to the call process. God has commanded us to pray in all situations, and even better, He has promised to hear our prayers. We are tempted to become anxious or despair. Prayer teaches us who is in control. It is an exercise of faith and piety. It helps us guard against the evil one. Pray for your congregation, your future pastor, his family, his congregation (if he is currently serving), your District President and Circuit Visitor, your congregational leadership, your vacancy pastor and whoever else is involved in the process.

Love each other. The call process can quickly bring up divisions in congregations. Love covers a multitude of sins. Forgive one another as God in Christ has forgiven you.

Study the Scriptures. The Pastoral Epistles (1 and 2 Timothy; Titus) are a great resource when thinking about pastors.

Study the Catechism. Here two parts are very important. The Fifth Chief part on the Office of the Keys and Confession (absolution), and the Table of Duties on Preachers and Hearers.

Prepare yourselves to receive your new pastor. Determine ways you can help him and his family move to the area, or get settled into the congregation. Plan to support your new Pastor by attending Worship services, and Bible Studies.
