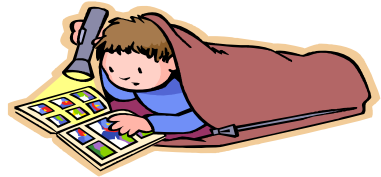

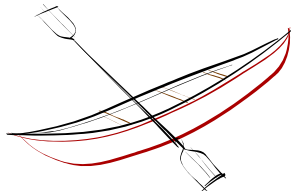

Congress can be a day trip or a 2-night camping trip depending on interest. It can also be a Father/Son or family event.

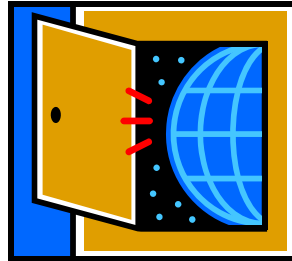
RA Summer Camp
