PRECEPT BIBLE STUDY:

The Precept Inductive Bible Study Method uses a straightforward Investigative approach to open the Bible and build the context for each statement it contains.

Inductive approach:

- ◆ Ask who, what, when, why, where and how
- ◆ Look for lists
- ◆ Mark key word and phrases
- ◆ Watch for contrasts and comparisons
- ◆ Note expressions of time
- ◆ Identify chapter themes

The group meets weekly for large group discussion led by Maureen Dobbins, praise & worship, fellowship and refreshments, and DVD lecture by Kay Arthur.
