Meet our LINKS Missionaries

Harmon and Beverly Schmelzenbach are our LINKS missionaries. They have devoted themselves to a life of service of promoting missions worldwide for the Church of the Nazarene. It began

when Harmon and Beverly answered God's call and were appointed to Africa, serving 17 years in South Africa. After Harmon officially registered the church in Botswana, they moved to Namibia and organized a Pioneer District there. In 1984 they went to Kenya to open the work of the Church in East Africa. By 1992 this work had

grown into eight nationally led districts covering Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Rwanda and Eastern Zaire, constituting hundreds of churches. In 1992 Harmon and Beverly moved to Addis Ababa to open the work in Ethiopia.

While training pastors in Kenya, Harmon's shared vision for a seminary resulted in the establishment of a university. With the opening and accreditation of Africa Nazarene University in Nairobi in September of 1994, an impossible task and dream came into being.

Some of the Schmelzenbach's responsibilities during their time of serving were overseeing the national church and church planting, opening the work of the church in new countries, organizing new districts, training of national leaders,

and establishing of the Africa Nazarene University.

Harmon and Beverly retired in 2001. We are both honored and proud to have them assigned to us as our LINKS missionaries.
