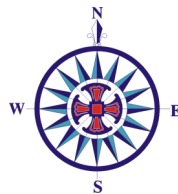

Children's Childcare opens at 8:45. Please sign your child (ages 6 weeks to 4 years old) in at the Noah's Ark building check-in desk. While we will be loving on all children, the 3 years old to kindergarten will be learning the bible story and creating goodies and making memories to take home with them. 1st grade and older will go to church with their parents. ***Please pick up your little ones (Nursery & Toddlers) right before Holy Communion. Children ages 3 & up will be escorted back to the main church service by their Sunday School teacher.

11:01am Walk...In Worship

Children's Sunday School opens at 10:45. Please sign your child (ages 6 weeks to 5th grade) in at the Noah's Ark building check-in desk. We gather for Praise & Worship, Prayer, Celebrations and teachings of the days lesson. Afterwards, they go to small groups for age-appropriate teachings and other exciting activities. Children ages 3 years old to 5th grade are escorted back to the main church service by their Sunday School teacher.

Noah's Ark Preschool-

Noah's Ark Preschool has been ministering to the lives of young children for over 35 years. We desire to integrate the Christian faith into all aspects of the children's daily routine through prayer, reading the Bible, song and model Christianity as a natural response to daily life. Through our curriculum *Beyond Centers and Circle Time* our children will grow and mature developmentally into avid and curious learners. They will have ample exposure to block play, dramatic play, painting, and water play wrapped in an environment rich in emergent literacy.

Our preschool serves children between the ages of 1 and 5, with a traditional preschool morning, Parents Day Out, Stay -N-Play and limited full time slots.



Holy Mackerel Kidz Summer Camp-

provides a wholesome Christ-centered summer experience for children entering Kindergarten-5th grade. Holy Mackerel includes Bible stories, plays, games, activities, field trips, opportunities for learning and great times with new friends! Every Friday is Waterday-so you are gonna get WET!!! Each action-packed, week-long session runs from Mon.-Fri., from 8:30-3:00 p.m. Camp fees are very reasonable; scholarships are available on a first-come, first-served basis. HMKSC runs various weeks through the summer. With special weeks to include 3 & 4 year olds. To kick off Summer 2011 we will begin with Youth week, June 6th- June 10th for grades 6th through 12th. Same excitement just geared for older students and more age appropriate teachings.

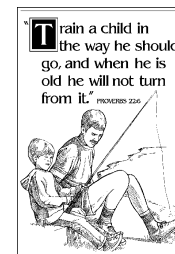
Mother's Day Luncheon-
