Confirmation instruction has begun for the year. This is not just an announcement, it is also a reminder. At Baptism, parents and sponsors are asked: "In Christian love you have presented this child for Holy Baptism. You should, therefore, faithfully bring him/her to the services of God's house...." They promise to do so. Today, I want to remind all parents and sponsors of the promise they made to God. How are you doing? How can we help?

At Confirmation, the students are asked, "You have made public profession of your faith. Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in Holy Baptism: to live among God's people, to hear his Word and share in his supper....?" They say, "I do, and I ask God to help and guide me." Today, I want to remind all who have confirmed their faith of the promises you have made to God. How are you doing? How can we help?

In the Liturgy: "God has made us his people through our Baptism into Christ. Living together in trust and hope, we confess our faith." Notice the plural: "**we** confess **our** faith." We gather together to be strengthened and to strengthen. Today I want to remind everyone: we need others and they need us. How are you doing? How can we help?

Whether it is at Baptism, or at Confirmation, or in weekly worship, we have learned how to say the words. But we are called to live and practice the faith. That is a lifelong discipline that takes place one day at a time. How are you doing? How can we help?

September 11, 2018**

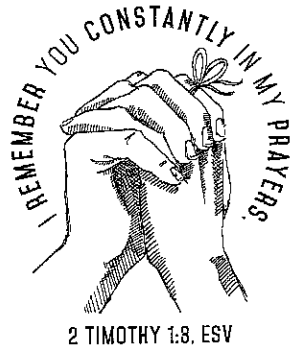

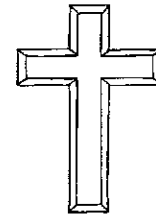

Hot dogs will be served and camp fires available for roasting marshmallows. Other food and beverages will also be provided.

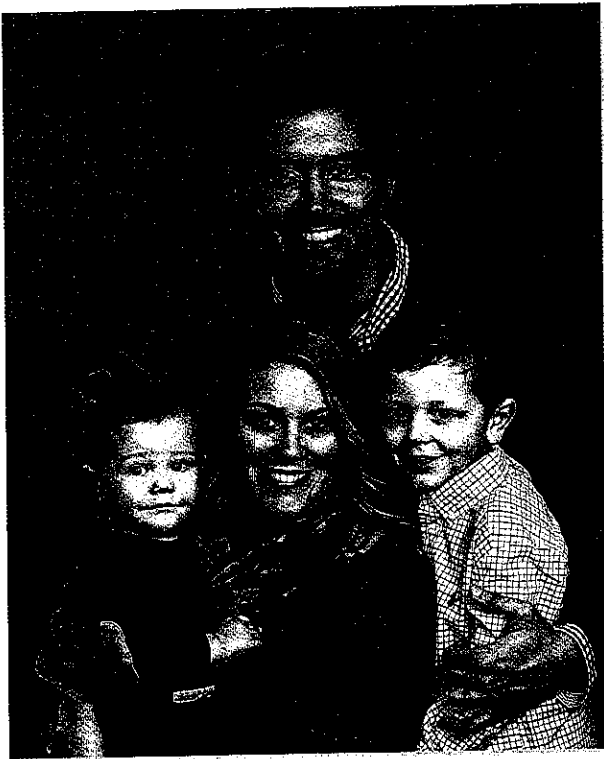
