

### THE VOICE OF IMMANUEL

May 2018

A friend of mine is the director of the choir at his church. He needed to notify the members of their schedule so he sent the following text: "Dear choir members: Remember there is no choir practice tomorrow, April 25. We will resume on May 2." Nothing too spectacular or noteworthy there – for anyone not in their choir. But it was very important to those who are. However, he accidentally included me on the group list. Now I know about their choir schedule. There is another "Jim" on his contact list who actually does sing in the choir. So, you could say that I was "accidentally called."

Jesus told his disciples, You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit. There was nothing accidental about his call to the disciples. It was intentional. It was good. It was purposeful. We remember at the beginning of the gospels, Jesus called them. "Follow me. I will make you fishers of people." They did not volunteer. In fact, they didn't know what was in store for them. Had they known, they would have thought long and hard about agreeing. Now, at the other end of Jesus' ministry, they still don't really know. If the past three years was any indication, it would simply be a matter of following, watching, occasionally going out on their own, and returning. No problem.

But that was not what the future would hold. Jesus said this on the night of his betrayal and arrest. The next day would be his crucifixion. They would soon be on their own and would preach the message of Law and Gospel. But would they be alone? When they faced the question of authority, how would they answer? And even more fundamentally, was their faith authentic or was it something they imagined? The assurance is the same. It is Jesus who called them. It is Jesus who sent them. The Holy Spirit created their faith and

empowered their witness. That is finally all they needed.

Hear those same words of Jesus, spoken to you! You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit. You did not simply stumble upon the faith. It was not some cosmic flip of the coin. It was not drawing straws and you got the short – or long – one. It was not a random or accidental pick from God's contact list. You have been chosen by our Lord. He used people; He used scripture; He used the Church. You do not have to worry that someone made up the faith and that you have been fooled all these years.

God is personally and intimately involved in your life. He has brought you to faith. He has nourished and nurtured you through the Sacraments so that you should go and bear fruit. God has created you to be a person. He has given you a place. He has given you a purpose. What tremendous assurance we have from the lips of Jesus himself.

When you wonder if you have any gifts or abilities that are useful in the kingdom of God, listen to Jesus. When you wonder if your life has any value, listen to Jesus. When you wonder if you can make any difference in the world, listen to Jesus. If you are old or young or somewhere in the middle, you are not alone. You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit.

I am glad that I received an accidental text. It gave us an opportunity to chat and enjoy a few laughs. I am happy that choir practice will resume on May 2, even if I won't be there. 

But much more, I celebrate the fact that God has called, chosen, and sent you into the world with the saving Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

### PARISH NURSING

God's richest blessings on you and your loved ones this month! We can feel stress related to problems in our relationships, spiritual well-being of loved ones, finances and our health. This month I want to discuss the relationship between Stress and Spirituality and Ways to Reduce our Stress Response.

Striking Stress with Spirituality: FROG

Fully Rely on God: "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus" (Php. 4:6,7).

Relax: close your eyes and slow down your breathing, scan your body for signs of stress, tense all muscles (starting with clenching your teeth & go down to your toes) as you take a breath in & slowly relax all with slow deep breaths using your belly rather than your chest. Repeat 4-5 times. Several other stress busters are: praying, diaphragmatic breathing, and meditating.

Observe: It is very important to be able to scan your body, mind and spirit in terms of where and how stress is affecting you. Try keeping a stress log.

God's Peace: "Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace" (Col. 3:15).
