

## **How Our Sunday School Works**

Who can attend? Children ages 3-7<sup>th</sup> grade. (8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders explore God's Word with our Immanuel Vicar and Mr. Roth in our youth group- YAC.) All children are welcome- we just ask that you register your family so that we can better prepare our yearly curriculum, the Christmas Eve service, and communicate news and events to you through email. When? 9:15-10:15am All children will start out in church for an opening bible message with Pastor or Vicar. (Families are welcome too-if a child is nervous to attend, parents may stay with them for as long as necessary to help them feel comfortable in the new setting.) The children will also have the opportunity to contribute an offering to a domestic or world mission. We then will celebrate birthdays, baptism birthdays, any "fruits of faith," and use music to prepare our hearts to hear God's Word. From there we will split into groups and the children will be lead to their classrooms by their teachers where they will dive into the bible lesson for the day. After application and craft time, the teachers will lead their students to the fellowship hall for parent pick- up.
