New Testament Survey

Course BI172 Instructor: Dr. Jim Schuppe

Students will enjoy discovering the various divisions of the New Testament as they study the historical and cultural context of each book. The author's intent, theology themes, and focus on Christ as the fulfillment of OT prophecy will also be emphasized. This class provides a great opportunity to grow in one's understanding of the original audience and application of each NT book, as well as making application for today.

Nehemiah: Biblical Principles of Leadership

Course BI275 Instructor: Dr. Mark Johnson

The Old Testament book of Nehemiah is an important historical link in the progress of revelation. It is also a very personal and practical journal taken from the life of a layman God greatly used. The man, Nehemiah, emerged as a model of a godly, servant leader who was used by God not only to complete a building project, but also to spiritually review the people of God. The course will survey the setting in OT history, the contents of the Biblical text, and the applications for living, serving, and leading as a man or woman of God.

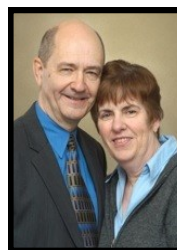
