

ROADWAYS TO REVIVAL IN PRAGUE

Isaiah 64:1 Oh that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains might quake at your presence — 2 as when fire kindles brushwood and the fire causes water to boil—to make your name known to your adversaries and that the nations might tremble at your presence!

Revival is the work of God. It is the outpouring of His Holy Spirit upon His people for His glory, in response to our repentance and prayer. When God's people are unified in one accord to passionately seek the Lord, reflect His holiness and express His love; He promises to rend the heavens and visit us and make His Name known among the nations. God chose to bring revival 600 years ago to Europe. He began the great awakening of His people in small chapel in Prague. That faithful gathering of believers was the fuel God used to ignite the reformation of His church and a great mission movement that spread around the world. We are in desperate need for God to again rend the heavens and come down. Let us pray He begins again here in Prague. May the Lord honor our desire to ask, seek and knock upon the gates of heaven in prayer and may He answer in awesome ways that we did not look for (Isaiah 64:3)

This simple chart is a tool to help believers pray for revival. Using the common modes of public transportation as prompts for prayer. As you travel through Prague each day, use these prompts to focus your prayers for the believers in Prague, for the lost to remember the Lord and for Jesus Name to be known in truth so that a revival may begin here and spread so that all nations.



Walk - Mighty God, grant me the grace to walk in integrity in my home, to walk in obedience and service to You, this day. Open my ears and mind to hear Your voice. Give me the courage to walk by faith looking for You, and for Your divine appointments this day to speak of Jesus to others. (Psalm 101:2, 2 Corinthians 5:7, 1 John 2:6)



Escalator/Steps: Down - Rend the heavens and come down Lord. Pray that God will pour out His Spirit like a mighty purifying flood. Ask God to cleanse our hearts as we pray for revival. Ask the Lord to move the mountain of unbelief in us and others through the power of His grace. Pray for God to bestow spiritual hunger in His people and draw them to fervent intercession. (Zechariah 4:6, Isaiah 64:1-3)



Escalator/Steps: Up - We bow before You, great God, there is none like You. We praise and lift up Your name for your alone are worthy. Praise the Lord for who He is and for what He has done. Pray His Names: Yahweh, Almighty, Savior, Healer, Provider, King, Righteous One, Jesus... We seek Your glory and the increase of Your Kingdom. Worship the Lord in the splendour of His holiness. (Psalm 77:11-13, Psalm 29:2)



Metro A - Ask that the people of this city may remember truth, and know Jesus as Savior and Lord. Pray for God to bestow spiritual hunger in His people and draw them to fervent intercession. Ask God to grant enable us to live as new creations and to become effective ambassadors for Christ. Ask the Lord for the boldness to believe that God will answer in ways that we did not expect. (2 Corinthians 5:17-21, Isaiah 64:3).



Metro B - Break our hearts over unbelief, both our own and the people around us. Pray that God will allow us to see ourselves and others through His eyes. Ask God to bring deep conviction of sin, spiritual brokenness, a holy fear of God and genuine repentance among all the people. The sacrifices that the Lord honors are broken spirit and a contrite heart. (2 Corinthians 7:10, Psalm 51:17)



Metro C - Church: Pray that God will bring loving unity among followers of Jesus, and a deep harmony between our churches. Pray for healing and for God to bring back those who have been hurt. Pray we will live the love of Christ with one another so that the world will see that we are His disciples. Pray that God will call thousands into ministry, missions and church planting. Pray for pastors and churches of Prague. (John 15:35, Ephesians 4:1-6)



Tram - Transformation: Pray that lives and relationships will be changed by the Power of God. Pray that those held captive by sin will be set free. Pray for Jesus to be known as Lord and Savior among all peoples. Ask the Lord to use you today to speak the gospel in His authority. Pray that God will complete His work in us so that we may rightly reflect Jesus to the people around us. (Acts 1:8, Matthew 28:18-19, Philippians 1:6)



Bus - Repentance/Surrender - Pray for a change of direction beginning in your own life, your church, in our city, and across the nations. There will be no revival without us humbling ourselves before God. Surrender your life to the Lord. Pray, Your will be done. Remember, "If we knew what God knows, we would always want what God wants." Trust Him with all that you are and will ever be, (2 Corinthians 7:10, 2 Chronicles 7:14, Isaiah 64:8)
