

# LOST ON THE WRONG ROAD

That very day two of them were going to a village named Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, <sup>14</sup> and they were talking with each other about all these things that had happened.

### Jesus' Presence is Mystery

While they were talking and discussing together, Jesus himself drew near and went with them. <sup>16</sup> But their eyes were kept from recognizing Him. <sup>17</sup> And He said to them, "What is this conversation that you are holding with each other as you walk?" And they stood still, looking sad. <sup>18</sup> Then one of them, named Cleopas, answered Him, "Are You the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days?" <sup>19</sup> And He said to them, "What things?"

### Mystery is revealed but not fully understood

And He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! <sup>26</sup> Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into His glory?" <sup>27</sup> And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, He interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.

## AWARENESS OF THE PRESENCE

So they drew near to the village to which they were going. He acted as if He were going farther, <sup>29</sup> but they urged Him strongly, saying, "Stay with us, for it is toward evening and the day is now far spent." So He went in to stay with them. <sup>30</sup> When He was at table with them, He took the bread and blessed and broke it and gave it to them. <sup>31</sup> And their eyes were opened, and they recognized Him. And He vanished from their sight.

### REVELATION AND MYSTERY AND PRESENCE

They said to each other, "Did not our hearts burn within us while He talked to us on the road, while He opened to us the Scriptures?" <sup>33</sup> And they rose that same hour and returned to Jerusalem. And they found the eleven and those who were with them gathered together, <sup>34</sup> saying, "The Lord has risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!" <sup>35</sup> Then they told what had happened on the road, and how He was known to them in the breaking of the bread. As they were talking about these things, Jesus himself stood among them, and said to them, "Peace to you!
