The **Gospel** of Freedom

The Gospel frees us from:
The present evil age (1:4)
Conforming to a
single culture/ethnicity (2:3)
Seeking salvation
from the law (2:15-16)
Slavery (4:3)
Acts of the flesh (5:19-21)

The Gospel frees us to:
Live in the grace of Christ (1:6)
Live fully within
ethnicity/culture (2:8)
Live in a way that
fulfills the law (5:14-18)
Become heirs (4:5-6)
Fruits of the Spirit (5:22-26)
