THREE SIGNS OF TOXICITY

HYPOCRISY LEGALISM JUDGMENTALISM

Where love is central, law loses its power and its necessity. Where love is absent, law becomes central and the best we can do.

(derived from Galatians 5:22-23)

CHECK THE LEVELS OF HYPOCRISY

Jesus began to speak first to his disciples, saying: "Be on your guard against the yeast of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy." Luke 12:1b

WOE TO THE HYPOCRITE

Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples: ² "The teachers of the law and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat. 3 So you must obey them and do everything they tell you [a lot of what they say is right]. But do not do what they do, for they do not practice what they preach. ⁴They tie up heavy loads and put them on men's shoulders, but they themselves are not willing to lift a finger to move them. ⁵ Everything they do is done for men to see: They make their phylacteries wide and the tassels on their garments long; ⁶ they love the place of honor at banquets and the most important seats in the synagogues; ⁷ they love to be greeted in the marketplaces and to have men call them Rabbi.' 11 The greatest among you will be your servant. ¹² For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted. 13 Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You shut the kingdom of heaven in men's faces. You yourselves do not enter, nor will you let those enter who are trying to. ²⁵Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you <u>hypocrites!</u> You clean the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of greed and self-indulgence. ²⁶ Blind Pharisee! First clean the inside of the cup and dish, and then the outside also will be clean. ²⁷ Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of dead men's bones

and everything unclean. ²⁸ In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness. 33 You snakes! You brood of vipers! How will you escape being condemned to hell?" Matthew 23:1-7; 11-13; 25-28; 33

→ G IVE FOR THE EYES OF GOD

"Be careful [warning and thought – easy to fall into the trap of making rules] not to do your 'acts of righteousness' before men, to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven. ² So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by men. I tell you the truth, they have received their reward in full. ³ But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, ⁴ so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you." Matthew 6:1-4

PRAY FOR THE EARS OF GOD

"And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites..."

Matthew 6:5a

→ PURSUE FOR THE HEART OF GOD

"When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do..." Matthew 6:16a

A KNIFE THAT CUTS BOTH WAYS

He told them still another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed into a large amount of flour until it worked all through the dough." Matthew 13:33

A SOBER AWARENESS
