# WHAT JESUS SAID BEFORE HE SAID WHAT HE SAID

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. <sup>18</sup> I tell you the truth, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished. <sup>19</sup> Anyone who breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do the same will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever practices and teaches these commands will be called great in the kingdom of heaven. <sup>20</sup> For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven."

# DO YOU WORSHIP JESUS OR THE BIBLE?

## CHECKING THE LEVELS OF LEGALISM

### **LEGALISM** (Rituals & Rule-based External Emphasis)

The Pharisees and some of the teachers of the law who had come from Jerusalem gathered around Jesus and <sup>2</sup> saw some of his disciples eating food with hands that were "unclean," that is, unwashed.

Mark 7:1-2

#### **BACK TO THE HEART**

He replied, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written: 'These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are

far from me. <sup>7</sup>They worship me in vain; their teachings are but rules taught by men.' <sup>8</sup>You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to the traditions of men.''

Mark 7:6-8

#### AN EXAMPLE

And he said to them: "You have a fine way of setting aside the commands of God in order to observe your own traditions! <sup>10</sup> For Moses said, 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'Anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death.' <sup>11</sup> But you say that if a man says to his father or mother: 'Whatever help you might otherwise have received from me is Corban' (that is, a gift devoted to God), <sup>12</sup> then you no longer let him do anything for his father or mother. <sup>13</sup> Thus you nullify the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And you do many things like that." *Mark 7:9-13* 

### **NOT EASY TO UNDERSTAND**

Again Jesus called the crowd to him and said, "Listen to me, everyone, and understand this. <sup>15</sup> Nothing outside a man can make him 'unclean' by going into him. Rather, it is what comes out of a man that makes him 'unclean.'" <sup>17</sup>After he had left the crowd and entered the house, his disciples asked him about this parable. <sup>18</sup> "Are you so dull?" he asked. "Don't you see that nothing that enters a man from the outside can make him 'unclean'? <sup>19</sup> For it doesn't go into his heart but into his stomach, and then out of his body." (In saying this, Jesus declared all foods "clean.") <sup>20</sup> He went on: "What comes out of a man is what makes him 'unclean.' <sup>21</sup> For from within, out of men's hearts, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, <sup>22</sup> greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. <sup>23</sup> All these evils come from inside and make a man 'unclean.'" *Mark 7:14-23* 

## A KNIFE THAT CUTS BOTH WAYS

He told them still another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed into a large amount of flour until it worked all through the dough."

Matthew 13:33

A Sober Awareness -- It's easy to slip into legalism.

An Obvious Confession -- I admit I can get legalistic.

**A Pattern of <u>Evaluation</u>** -- I need a pattern in which the Father searches and tests my motives and actions.

**An <u>Authentic</u> Community --** I need people in my life who understand and accept where I am on my journey and will walk with me as I take another step toward God.
