• At least a dozen times Proverbs focuses on the importance of diligence in one's work life - warning those who love <u>sleep</u>, the <u>lazy</u>, and the <u>sluggard</u>.

Lazy hands make a man poor, but diligent hands bring wealth.

Proverbs 10:4

- The wise man illustrates diligence by focusing on the <u>ant</u>.

 Proverbs 6:6-11
- Very clearly, God's way to financial prosperity is work.

GUARDED BY WISDOM

He who works his land will have abundant food, but the one who <u>chases fantasies</u> will have his fill of poverty.

²⁰ A faithful man will be richly blessed, but one eager to get <u>rich</u> will not go unpunished.

Proverbs 28:19-20

The plans of the diligent lead to profit as surely as <u>haste</u> leads to poverty.

Proverbs 21:5

- The wise man has learned "if it's too good to be true, it probably isn't true."
- Beware of <u>shortcuts</u> to making money! Let <u>wisdom</u> guard your financial decisions.

GUIDED BY INTEGRITY

He whose walk is blameless is kept safe, but he whose ways are perverse will suddenly fall. Proverbs 28:18

Proverbs 11:1

The wicked man earns <u>deceptive</u> wages, but he who sows righteousness reaps a sure reward Proverbs 11:18

A greedy man brings trouble to his family, but he who hates <u>bribes</u> will live.
