# GENEROUS LIVING

#### SEES THEIR NEEDS

If a man shuts his <u>ears</u> to the <u>cry</u> of the poor, he too will cry out and not be answered.

Proverbs 21:13

He who gives to the poor will lack nothing, but he who closes his <u>eyes</u> to them receives many curses.

Proverbs 28:27

- 15.6% of the people in Eau Claire live under the poverty level.
- You can't help everyone, but can help those the LORD puts in front of you.

### RESETS OUR ATTITUDES

He who <u>despises</u> his neighbor sins, but blessed is he who is <u>kind</u> to the needy. Proverbs 14:21

A poor man pleads for mercy, but a rich man answers <u>harshly</u>.

Proverbs 18:23

Haughty eyes and a proud heart... are sin.

Proverbs 21:4

- We have a tendency to judge the poor.
- The wise man recognizes self-imposed poverty (lazy, sluggard, loves sleep).
- He also recognizes poverty through injustice. Proverbs 13:23
- 3.6 million people in the U.S. are paid at or below minimum wage.
- 13.9 million Americans are unemployed (as of May 2011).
- In 2010, 1.6 million Americans filed for bankruptcy.
- 60% of bankruptcies result from overwhelming medical bills.
- We should be very slow to judge someone else's circumstances.

## RECOGNIZES THE SPIRITUAL IMPLICATIONS

He who oppresses the poor shows <u>contempt</u> for their Maker, but whoever is kind to the needy <u>honors</u> God.

Proverbs 14:31

He who is kind to the poor <u>lends</u> to the LORD, and he will reward him for what he has done.

Proverbs 19:17

The King will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.'
