DAY ONE

Is it a small seed, plant, or tree which others come to you and rest? **PRAY** that your influence, no matter how large or small, will spread to others like yeast through dough. **BE** thankful!

DAY TWO

READ Psalm 107:2-7 and Matthew 28:16-20.

What's your story? Are you still wandering through the desert wasteland? Are you hungry and thirsty? If so, **CRY** out to the Lord in your distress. Has God redeemed you? Has He settled you? If so, whom are you telling as you go? Let Him lead you as you **SHARE** your story with someone today.

DAY THREE

READ Psalm 107:8-9.

Are you thirsty for more? Are you hungry for good things? Do you feel God's unfailing love? **TALK** to Him about it. **GO** over your list from Day One. **ADD** a few more names. **GIVE** thanks to the Lord. Prayer and worship are powerful tools which help satisfy thirst and hunger. They're powerful ways to feel God's unfailing love.

PRAY for DAN & NAOMI. **PRAY** for...

...them as they serve in another country these next two weeks.
...opportunities to share, encourage, and help native believers start small businesses.
...peace for their son Eddie during this short separation as he stays with his grandparents in CO.

DAY FOUR

READ Psalm 108:1-3 and Matthew 5:13-16.

What's your song today? Does music fill your soul? Do you add flavor to the lives of those around you? Are you sharing your light? How do you live out your light? Do you want your life to make a difference? Are you ready to serve? **PRAY** about discerning what your next step may be.

PRAY for ADAM & MARY -- HEATHER & DAVE. **PRAY** for...

...them as they get ready for fall outreaches on the UWEC campus and forming new Bible studies.
...their vision of student transformation, campus renewal, and developing world changers to become realities.

DAY FIVE

READ Psalm 108:3-5 and James 1:27.

Are you concerned about the poor? Widows? Orphans? **PRAISE** God because His eye is on the lost and the lonely. How is God calling you to grow? Are you ready to step up into prayer? Or maybe to serve? Are you ready to trade your American dream for God's dream? **PRAY** for God's direction and discernment.
