HE SHOWS ME A PATH THROUGH MY PROBLEM

Early the next morning Abraham took some food and a skin of water and gave them to Hagar. He set them on her shoulders and then sent her off with the boy. She went on her way and wandered in the desert of Beersheba. ¹⁵ When the water in the skin was gone, she put the boy under one of the bushes. ¹⁶ Then she went off and sat down about a bowshot away, for she thought, "I cannot watch the boy die." And as she sat there, she began to sob. ¹⁷ God heard the boy crying, and the angel of God called to Hagar from heaven and said to her, "What is the matter, Hagar? Do not be afraid; God has heard the boy crying as he lies there. ¹⁸ Lift the boy up and take him by the hand, for I will make him into a great nation." ¹⁹ Then **God opened her eyes** and **she saw** a well of water. So she went and filled the skin with water and gave the boy a drink.

But God was very angry when he went, and the angel of the LORD stood in the road to oppose him. Balaam was riding on his donkey, and his two servants were with him. ²³ When the donkey saw the angel of the LORD standing in the road with a drawn sword in his hand, she turned off the road into a field. Balaam beat her to get her back on the road.

Then the LORD opened the donkey's mouth, and she said to Balaam, "What have I done to you to make you beat me these three times?"

²⁹ Balaam answered the donkey, "You have made a fool of me! If only I had a sword in my hand, I would kill you right now." ³⁰ The donkey said to Balaam, "Am I not your own donkey, which you have always ridden, to this day? Have I been in the habit of doing this to you?" "No," he said.

³¹ Then the LORD **opened Balaam's eyes**, and **he saw** the angel of the LORD standing in the road with his sword drawn. So he bowed low and fell facedown.

HOW CAN I SEE WHAT HE'S SHOWING ME?

- Ask yourself, "Am I following Christ?"
- Ask the Holy Spirit to open your eyes and illuminate your mind. Medidate on Psalm 119:18 Open my eyes that I might see wonderful things in your law. (week 2 memory verse)
- Check your heart and attitude. That changes everything He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his way.
