GRACE IS THE GROUT

...even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved— ⁶ and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁷ so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. Ephesians 2:5-7 ESV

FOR SALVATION

For by grace you have been saved through faith.

And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,

not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Ephesians 2:8-9 ESV

FOR LIFE

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Ephesians 2:10 ESV

THEREFORE, REMEMBER

Therefore remember that at one time you Gentiles in the flesh...

Ephesians 2:11a ESV

(see also Revelation 2:1-7)

We're broken pieces which God (the Artist) brings together to create something unique, beautiful, and everlasting.
