

### ~ marriage ~

a covenant between God, a man and a woman, their families, and the greater community.

Marriage is a lifetime commitment to glorify God by loving each other, working for the common good of both families and the community, usually to produce and raise children who will seek to continue the practice and purpose of family and marriage.

# ~ singleness ~

a calling from God in which an individual lives celibate and does not participate in the pleasures and responsibilities of marriage.

The purpose of singleness is to glorify God and to work for the common good of community and families.

# the design of marriage

The man gave names to all livestock and to the birds of the heavens and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper fit for him. <sup>21</sup> So the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and while he slept took one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh. <sup>22</sup> And the rib that the LORD God had taken from the man he made into a woman and brought her to the man. <sup>23</sup> Then the man said, "This at last is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man." <sup>24</sup> Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh. <sup>25</sup> And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.
