Wednesday Night's focus scriptures will be on Psalm 107

NOTE: this Psalm serves as a mandate on "cause and effect" concerning the sovereign grace of God in light of the surrendered heart of man. We must conclude that there is no situation so desperate nor depraved that the flowing flooding impact of God's life source cannot overcome. In each of these situations it was the outcry of desperation that allowed these wandering rebellious hearts to become anchored recipients of God's grace. Each of us at one time in our lives were in one or more of these lost conditions. The question remains, do we give thanks to the Lord for His lovingkindness as we come into His presence? Do we remember His gracious work in our lives? Have we inclined our hearts to exalt His Holiness with gladness that we might flow from His inhabited House, changing the dry lands into springs of water?
