

Lunch and Snacks



You will be responsible for providing a lunch for your child each day. Please send finger foods that your child will eat, in a labeled container. Whole milk will be provided for lunch. If you want your child to drink something else, please also send that drink in a labeled cup with lid. If your child has no food allergies, you will be placed on a snack schedule. You will be asked to provide snacks for the entire class for one week during the school year. The rest of the year, your child will eat the snacks that are provided by his/her classmates. **If your child has any food allergies or follows a special diet, please be in close communication with your teacher.**

Arrival and Pick Up

Each teacher will be ready to greet their children @8:55am. You will bring your child to **his/her own classroom and sign them in at the door.** Please keep this interaction short and sweet. Your teacher will have plenty of fun activities planned once they get inside the classroom. Our school day ends at 1:00pm. You will also be required to sign out your child when you arrive. If your child is not picked up by 1:05pm, he/she will be taken to Extended Day. After 2:00 pm you will be required to pay \$1.00 per minute. If an emergency arises which delays you, please call **225-923-2317** and inform us of the problem. We appreciate your promptness.

Extended Day

Beginning Monday, **September 24th**, children may stay until **2:00 pm**. This will be available each day, and for this additional hour we will charge \$7.00 per child. Each time that you use extended care, we ask you to communicate with your teacher (texting, if needed) which child will be staying, and who will pick up your child. Payment is due at time of pickup, and may not be combined with tuition.

Records

We need a copy of your child's Immunization Record. This is the form given to you by your pediatrician, showing the dates of vaccinations. Please give this form to your teacher during the first week of school. It can also be faxed to the church office at 225-929-6952.



Illness

Each family will be given a copy of our health policy at Open House. Please review this policy and adhere to our rules and regulations. Please notify your teacher if your child will not be attending due to illness. You will be called to pick up your child if he/she becomes ill while at MDO. Please **DO NOT** ask teachers to administer medications. If your child has been sick, he/she may return to school after being fever-free for 24 hours. We'll do our best to ensure illnesses are not spread within the classrooms. We ask that you also take precautions determining when to send your child to school.

Severe Weather

We strictly follow the EBR Parish schools regarding closures, delayed start times, or early pick up times. Their policy will determine when to open and close MDO. We may also dismiss early on our own volition if we experience extreme weather. It is important that you watch for text messages, emails, or phone calls when severe weather is imminent. The safety of our children is our top priority.



Teaching Staff

Christian teachers are always available to guide, love, and listen to your child. Teachers plan interesting and engaging activities incorporating songs, stories, skills, arts and crafts while sharing about God's love on the level of each child. Our class sizes are conducive to meeting the needs of each unique individual.

Clothing

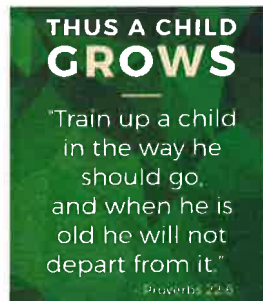

At MDO, we want your child to experience God's love for him through loving relationships and meaningful encounters. Because each child is growing physically, mentally, socially, and spiritually, we provide a variety of positive learning activities. Young children learn through active exploration of their environment through self-initiated and teacher-selected activities. Our early childhood environment will provide opportunities for your child to explore materials, engage in concrete activities, and interact with peers and adults.



Learning Centers

Learning centers are clearly defined areas/activities within a classroom where children can explore and learn with hands-on materials. Research shows that young children learn best through active, hands-on play. These centers engage children and make learning fun. Children manipulate materials, explore ideas, discover consequences, build, create and express themselves through art. To parents it may look like children are "just playing" but this is play with a purpose. Through carefully planned learning centers, children learn important concepts and life skills in ways that are meaningful to them. For deeper learning to occur, children need time to manipulate materials and process what they have learned.

Curriculum

In order for children to reach their full potential during these early learning years, it is important that we provide an environment that promotes growth and learning. Our curriculum will be guided by Louisiana's Birth to Five Early Learning & Development Standards (ELDS). This curriculum is child-centered, educationally sound, and developmentally based.



TechStars presents TechTime as a part of the MDO curriculum in our oldest classes. Students will enjoy a monthly circle time where a new piece of software is introduced each month by CT – the Computer Turtle Mascot. Throughout the month, the students will be able to practice their new technology skills in the computer center in the classroom. Preschool skills come alive at MDO in many ways!

Library

This is wonderful time to instill the love of reading & books! Our 2-year old classes & 3-year old classes will also go to the library. These classes will listen to a selection of age appropriate & engaging books ready by JBC volunteers.

*Learning Centers —These areas include: Home-living, block and construction puzzles, books, art, writing, science and sensory, math and manipulatives	*Group Times —Stories, songs, games, and music activities are planned. Age appropriate skills are addresses such as letters, numbers, colors and shapes. These concepts vary due to the ability level of each class.
*Outside Time — Play is supervised outdoors, with activities planned inside during inclement weather	*Lunch Time — Parents provide a lunch for their children. Nutritional finger foods in easily opened containers are suggested.

MDO Families

Monday, Aug. 27, at 7:00 pm, we will have an **Open House for parents only** in the church auditorium. We will gather to review policies and procedures. You will then proceed to your child's classroom to meet your teachers. Please make a special effort to join us!



On **Tuesday, Aug. 28**, we will have a **"Get-Acquainted Time"** for all classes. Children whose last names begin with the letters **A-J** should arrive between 9:00 - 10:00 am. Those with last names between **K-Z** should arrive between 10:30 - 11:30 am. This will be the time for **you and your child to visit** with the teacher and meet other friends that will be in the class.

Notice About September 4-11:

The first day of school is **Tuesday, September 4th**. We look forward to getting to know you and your precious family throughout this school year!

To help your children make the transition from home to school, we will shorten the school day for the first week only. The day will begin at 8:55 am, and will dismiss at 12:00 pm. We will not have lunch.

Beginning Thursday, September 13, the normal hours of 8:55 am to 1:00 pm will take effect.

Supplies

- All children will need:
- * A labeled back pack
- * A labeled cup with a top
- * A labeled lunch box
- * A change of clothing
- * Disposable diapers / pull-ups (if applicable)



Your child's safety is our top priority. We will have a security guard on campus during MDO hours. Our building is also locked at all times. You will need an electronic card that is called a fob to enter our building. Each family will be issued a fob at Open House.

Program Policies

Enrollment

Enrollment is open to any Preschooler, 12-months through 3 years, provided our program can meet the needs of that child. Children are enrolled with standing reservations for the school year (on a first-come-first-served basis). A \$250 per child Registration and "All Supplies" fee is payable upon enrollment and it is Non-Refundable. This program is a 9-month commitment. Our school year begins in September and ends in May.



Monthly Tuition (per child)

2 days per week:	\$180/month	\$1,620/year
3 days per week:	\$210/month	\$1,890/year
4 days/week (3's only):	\$245/month	\$2,205/year

Your tuition payment is due on the 1st of each month and is considered late if it is not received by the 5th of each month. There will be a \$15.00 late fee assessed if your payment is not received by this date. **Monthly tuition remains the same for each month, with no deductions for absences or scheduled vacation days.**

You have two options in paying your monthly tuition. These options were developed to assist you in making your payments in a timely manner.

- 1) Arrange with your bank to draft your account. Make sure the payments include your child's first and last name as well as the family name associated with our MDO records.
- 2) Log into the MDO website (www.jeffersonbaptist.org/Ministries/MDO) and click on the link to pay your tuition. You can use your credit card or bank account.

Withdrawals

Withdrawals from the program will be considered through February and require a 30-day written notice. Special circumstances may arise if a family has to move mid-year. Please see the director if any other special circumstances develop. You will not be able to withdraw your child from our program after February. Remaining school year tuition will be due and full payment will be expected to consider your child leaving in good standing. **Your registration is a commitment to our program concluding in May.**
