Elinor began quilting in 1974 when she had corduroy fabric leftover from making rompers for her sons. She either machine or hand pieces her quilts, but only hand quilts them. She is most recognized for her hand quilting,

her favorite.

Elinor began creating one inch to one foot scale quilts when she began to outfit her beautiful doll house. She is a member of N.A.M.E, the National Association of Miniature Enthusiasts.

When asked what is her greatest joy in quilting, she answered with a smile, "The people! I truly enjoy seeing my students' quilts win awards."


