Homework:

- 1. The Pharisees, who were arguably the most religious people of their time, are an example of having faith but not necessarily a "saving faith." How does Jesus' response to the Pharisees in **Matthew 23** (the seven woes) further illustrate how we can have faith but miss the mark on having a saving faith?
- In contrast to the seven woes we read in Matthew 23, Jesus gave us eight Beatitudes to show how we can live a life that demonstrates authentic faith. As you read through Matthew 5:1-11, jot down how the eight Beatitudes differ from the seven woes and then answer the following questions.
 - a. How would you explain each beatitude to someone who was brand new to Christianity?
 - b. Which beatitude is most challenging for you to live out in your own life?
 - c. How do the Beatitudes relate to being "salt and light" in Matthew 5:13-16?
- 3. What do the following verses teach us about the difference between knowledge and obedience according to God?
