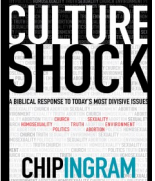

Begins Sept 11th

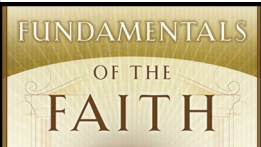

An ALL church gathering of prayer. Worship based prayer time that is Scripture fed and Spirit led. Meets at the Journey with the Elders.



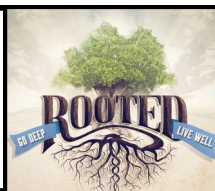
# Open Growth Groups
