- Paul walked into this city.
- Paul came to sow the seeds of the gospel in this city.
- Paul came with <u>weakness</u>, <u>fear</u> and <u>trembling</u>
 (I Corinthians 2:3)
- Paul came into this city with a <u>strategy.</u>
