The Issue

Three Questions from the Text

1. Why are lawsuits forbidden against your brother?

Four reasons:

1.	Because by doing this you are submitting to the wisdom of this world. (I Corinthians 1:18-20; Matthew 19:28; Revelation 3:21)
2.	Because they were <u>conforming</u> to the world. (I Peter 2:18-21)
3.	Because you're <u>hurting</u> your <u>witness</u> . (Philippians 2:3-5)
4.	Because you are already <u>defeated</u> once you do it.

2. Is all litigation bad? (Romans 13:1-5; I Peter 2:1-14)

 How should the church respond to conflict? (Matthew 18:15-17; Galatians 6:1; Matthew 5:23-24; Romans 12:18)
