¹ This book contains great arguments against the theory of evolution. The author is a lawyer from U.C. Berkley! His latest book is *Wedge of Truth*.

² Dr. Michael Denton is not a Christian nor a creationist scientist (at least at the time he wrote this book), but he is an honest "truth seeker" & he believes that the **present theory** of evolution has very little scientific basis for being valid. He is a micro-biologist & presents devastating scientific arguments against the theory of evolution from the study of micro-biology and DNA research. He shares excellent insights into the contradictions of the theory of evolution. His conclusion, based on these findings, is that macro-evolution is scientifically impossible! This book is very scientific, but every chapter begins with a quote either from Charles Darwin or some other key person in the evolution-creation issue. The chapter then discusses the implication of the quote. At the end of one chapter, Dr. Denton publishes a letter written by Darwin's wife [who was a Christian!] and it is very moving, for Darwin adds in his own handwriting that; "When I am dead, no one will ever know how often I cried over this letter". So there is a lot of historical information in this book that most reader's would find interesting. Dr. Duane Gish, from the Institute Of Creation Research, and his wife had dinner with Dr. Denton & his wife to discuss some of these issues! For writing this book, Dr. Denton lost his position as professor of micro-biology at the University of Australia. He is continuing to do biological research and is now writing another book in France in rebuttal to the critics of this first book.
