Questions for Reflection:

3. What has been your experience of Christians and how they interact with one another? How would you say we are doing at “keeping the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace” (v.3)?
4. If you consider yourself a follower of Jesus, how have you done at this in the recent past? What are some challenges to you doing this well?
5. What difference does it make that there is only one body, one Spirit, one hope, one Lord, one faith, and one God?
6. What would be the effect in our city or nation if the body of Christ really operated in unity and recognized that we are one? What is one step you can take in this direction this week?
