For 20 years, we have been a lighthouse on the lake, sharing the love of Christ with others. We have often said that we want to make it hard for people to go to hell from here. The "Tell the Story" emphasis is designed to make it easy for you to share Christ with those in your home and beyond through His story (the gospel of Jesus Christ) and your story (your personal testimony).

The Tell the Story campaign is strategically located in the middle of a sermon theme that we began in February called SPLASH! Thus far, I have challenged you to:

S – Set your heart toward the lost and Shine your light in the darkness.

P – Pray for the lost and for laborers who will go tell the lost about Jesus.

L – Look for opportunities in our communities. Look at home first, then ripple out.

A – Act on those opportunities in our communities and Attack the darkness.

S – Share Jesus with others using His story (the gospel) and Your story (your testimony).

Next Sunday, we will challenge you with the H in SPLASH. But today, we want you to get started learning at home how to share Jesus with others.

Please accept this kit as our gift to you and your family to help you get started sharing your own faith story with others. You will also learn a simple way to share His story by taking part in our witness training. Included in this kit is a guide to help you understand this strategy, a recipe card called "Couples Date Night," and a "Tell Your Story" card that will walk you through developing your own faith story. Over the next three Sundays, we will provide an additional recipe card that you and your family can use to help you Tell the Story.

In three weeks, Sunday, April 2nd, we're going to have Splash Day at LFBC. It will be our big baptism day in the morning service and we hope someone you know will be baptized because you and your family were able to tell the story at home and beyond!
