

Ways to Give to LGPC in 2017

1. **Cash or Check.** Periodically, either weekly, monthly, quarterly or annually.
2. **Automatic Bank Withdrawal (ACH).** Contact Elaine in the church office (503) 636-5656 or send an email to: elaines@lakegrovepres.org.

3. **Electronic Giving.** You can go to our website, <http://lakegrovepres.org/#/donate> and click on the big red P on the right hand side of the page. You can also use your smart phone by downloading the PushPay App or text "LGPC" to 77977.



4. **Appreciated Stock.** You are entitled to a tax deduction for charitable contribution of the value of stock as of the date of your gift, irrespective of your basis, without having to pay tax on the capital gain.

To transfer stock to Lake Grove Presbyterian Church, send a letter to your broker instructing him or her to transfer xxx shares of ABC stock to the following account:

Send our bookkeeper an email or a letter advising us as to the stock and number of shares transferred, as well as how you would like the proceeds to be distributed. For example, "\$X to my 2017 pledge and the balance to ____." Our bookkeeper is Elaine Stinson and her email is: (ElaineS@lakegrovepres.org). 5. **Direct Contribution from Individual Retirement Account.** If you are 70 ½ years or older, this can fulfill your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). If you qualify by age, donations up to \$100,000 may be made directly from your IRA without incurring income tax consequences. Such donations will fulfill, in whole or in part, RMD requirements. It can be more tax efficient to donate directly because of potential limitations on deductions and the alternative minimum tax. Consult your tax advisor for application to your circumstances.
