### PIPE ORGAN FUND UPDATE

Members and friends of our congregation have generously supported the Pipe Organ Fund which paid for renovations to the sanctuary several years ago. In order to complete that project, we borrowed \$175,000. To date, the balance on that loan is \$39,000. We expect to receive \$17,000 in pledges that are currently outstanding and we have \$17,247 in the fund which is used to make our monthly payments. If you have not yet fulfilled your pledge, please do so as soon as you can. If you would like to contribute to help retire this debt, we invite you to do so. We hope to pay off this loan by the end of this year.



### LAKESIDE'S LABYRINTH
