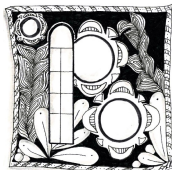

Thanks to the Honor Society students from Rocky Mount High and lots of help from the folks from Good Shepherd, we were able to complete the priming on all of the hive tops and the remaining boxes. We now need to schedule some days to apply one coat of semi-gloss paint and complete the assembly of the hives.

We will work on Saturday, March 17, 8:30–1:00, April 14, 8:30–1:00 and April 21, 8:30–1:00. Should we need more time, April 28 and/or May 5 would be options! We will meet at Church of the Good Shepherd.

We need to raise approximately \$7,300.00 to purchase the hive foundations (\$30 per hive—where the bees are raised and the honey is produced and stored), feeders, and miscellaneous hardware that supports the hive.
