## SUMMER WORSHIP SERIES

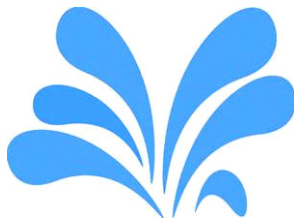

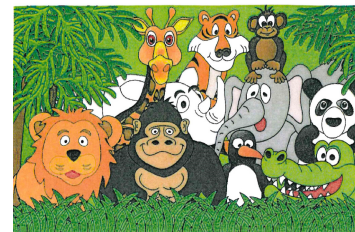
