THE FREDERICK E. TURNAGE DISTINGUISHED SPEAKER SERIES AT LAKESIDE: CONVERSATIONS IN CHRISTIAN CITIZENSHIP JANUARY 11-12, 2015

We look forward to welcoming Dr. Gary Gunderson and Dr. Teresa Cutts as our speakers for this year's Turnage Speaker Series. The focus of their presentations will be "Leading Causes of Life: Faith and Health in Our Community." Dr. Gunderson will preach on Sunday morning, January 11. Both Dr. Gunderson and Dr. Cutts will speak and facilitate discussion on Sunday evening at 7:00 p.m. Dr. Gunderson will also lead a time of discussion on Monday morning at 9:00 a.m. in Robbins Hall. All of these events are open to the public and without charge. Please encourage family and friends to join us for this important conversation as we honor the memory of our friend Fred Turnage and explore the ways in which we might live out our faith as good citizens.

Dr. Gary Gunderson is Vice President for Faith and Health at Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center and Professor of Religion and the Health of the Public at Wake Forest University Divinity School. He is a graduate of Candler School of Theology at Emory University (MDiv) and The Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta (DMin).

Dr. Teresa Cutts serves as Research Assistant Professor at Wake Forest School of Medicine, with the majority of her time dedicated to aiding in the evaluation and design of FaithHealthNC. She was trained in clinical health psychology and currently holds a visiting faculty appointment at the University of Capetown's School of Public Health and Family Medicine.
