SON OF GOD MASS ❖ ASH WEDNESDAY



On Wednesday, February 13, at 6:30 p.m. as part of the Ash Wednesday Service, the Lakeside Chancel Choir will perform a modern work by English composer James Whitbourn entitled *Son of God Mass*. The piece will be directed by Amy Shortt and accompanied by Mark Gansor on organ and Michael Stephenson on soprano saxophone.

This devotional concert piece will be interwoven throughout the Ash Wednesday service. The evocative sound of the soprano saxophone adds a healing balm over the whole piece making it a profound consolatory experience.

The movements of the mass express a wide range of emotions from joy and sorrow to hope and peace which can be reflective of the wide range of life experiences. The beginning movement, *Kyrie*, an earnest plea for mercy leads to the *Gloria*, a triumphant celebration that mercy has been granted. The middle movement or center of the work, *Lava Me*, is a solemn prayer for cleansing and ties into the scripture reading for Ash Wednesday, "Create in me a clean heart, O God and renew within me a right spirit." The reassuring awe of *Sanctus* and *Benedictus* brings a prayer for peace to one another through the *Pax Domini*. The mysterious *Agnus Dei* leads finally to a glorious *Amen* affirming hope in the grace of God and the triumph of the human spirit.

Music is a powerful form of spiritual expression. It is intended that this worship experience will build into both journey and story that will be life affirming and life changing. The great teacher of the twentieth century, Nadia Boulanger said, "All that we know by heart enriches us and helps us find ourselves." It is our hope that all who attend will listen, not only with their ears, but especially with their heart and that this music will allow us all to see ourselves a bit more clearly in the midst of life's experiences.
