

actIon [3] **I act on...Cooperation**

Series Theme:

“So we built the wall...for the people had a mind to work.” (Nehemiah 4:6)

Last Week: When you see a need, respond with prayer, courage and *action*.

Nehemiah’s profile of courage (Neh. 2):

- Courage is facing up rather than ducking out
- Courage is venturing out rather than holding back
- Courage comes from leaning on rather conjuring up

Today:

Nehemiah 3:1-2 Eliashib the high priest and his fellow priests went to work and rebuilt the Sheep Gate. They dedicated it and set its doors in place, building as far as the Tower of the Hundred, which they dedicated, and as far as the Tower of Hananel. ²The men of Jericho built the adjoining section, and Zaccur son of Imri built next to them... ⁵The next section was repaired by the men of Tekoa, but their nobles would not put their shoulders to the work under their supervisors... ²⁰Next to him, Baruch son of Zabbai zealously repaired another section, from the angle to the entrance of the house of Eliashib the high priest.
