### *Lesson 2 – Remember (Ps. 106)*

**Series Theme:** Learn from history to live more fully today.

For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope. **Romans 15:4**

*This week:* **Learn from history--to remember who God is and what He has done.**

<sup>7</sup> When our fathers were in Egypt, they gave no thought to your miracles; they did not remember your many kindnesses, and they rebelled by the sea, the Red Sea. <sup>8</sup> Yet he saved them for his name's sake, to make his mighty power known. <sup>9</sup> He rebuked the Red Sea, and it dried up; he led them through the depths as through a desert. <sup>10</sup> He saved them from the hand of the foe; from the hand of the enemy he redeemed them. <sup>11</sup> The waters covered their adversaries; not one of them survived. <sup>12</sup> Then they believed his promises and sang his praise. <sup>13</sup> But they soon forgot what he had done and did not wait for his counsel...
