Series Theme:

“...You will always harvest what you plant.” Galatians 6:7 [NLT]

Today:

<sup>6</sup>Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. <sup>7</sup>You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. “For God loves a person who gives cheerfully.” <sup>8</sup>And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others. <sup>9</sup>As the Scriptures say, “They share freely and give generously to the poor. Their good deeds will be remembered forever.” <sup>10</sup>For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, he will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you. <sup>11</sup>Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous. And when we take your gifts to those who need them, they will thank God. <sup>12</sup>So two good things will result from this ministry of giving—the needs of the believers in Jerusalem will be met, and they will joyfully express their thanks to God. 2 Corinthians 9:6-12 [NLT]
