Today:

⁷Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. ⁸For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. ⁹And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. ¹⁰So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith. Galatians 6:7-10

Theme: Live now so you'll be happy at harvest.

How can you live now so you're happy at harvest?

-Plant in the right field

-the wrong field

-the flesh – the fallen, broken, wayward part of us

-When we live to satisfy the flesh, it will result in “corruption,” it will destroy us.

-the right field

-the Spirit – the Holy Spirit

-When we live to satisfy the Spirit, it will result in life—full, satisfying, rich, eternal life.

-Take the “now” opportunities to do good

-to everyone

-particularly those in the family of faith

-Don't get discouraged or give out in doing good

-at just the right time

-the harvest will come.
