

Pumpkin Patch Fundraiser Fall 2012

NOTE We are now sharing this fundraiser with the Chancel Choir. The blue bars on the schedule linked below are for the choir and the white bars are for the youth and their families to sign up on.

Rules for signing up and working at the Pumpkin Patch:

-Please check your own calendar BEFORE signing up.

-One adult is required per shift, designated on the schedule by an (A). An adult is anyone who is over 18 and has completed high school. Any time slot without an (A) is available for student workers. Students must be in 6th – 12th grade to participate.

- The maximum number of shifts that you can sign up for prior to October 10 is three; after that, you can sign up for as many of the remaining shifts as you like (this is to give everyone a fair chance at the schedule).

- Shifts scheduled for parents count toward the number a student is allowed to schedule (so you can't sign up for three for yourself and three for your parent...it's three in TOTAL per family through Oct. 10).

-Students will receive a discount on future trips for any shifts they work themselves and for any shifts worked by their parents.

- No student workers during The Well(Bible study) or The Wave(UMYF).

-Only properly scheduled shifts count; please do not show up and expect to receive credit if you're not signed up.

-Exceptions: Thursday, October 11th from 3pm till 7pm Pallet, Tent & Light set-up.

Sunday, October 14 at 3:00 p.m. (pumpkin arrival time), we need EVERYONE's help; no prior sign-up required, but would be appreciated! The pumpkins are supposed to be extra large this year, so could use some extra muscle.

-Please arrive on time, sign in when you arrive and sign out when you leave. You must follow the shift rules that will be printed on the table, or you will not get credit for you shift.

-ALL additions, changes or corrections to the schedule MUST go through Stacey McClennen at scmcclennen@sbcglobal.net by sending her the dates, shift hours, who will be working and a phone number; Just writing your name on a list is not enough, you must receive confirmation from her.
