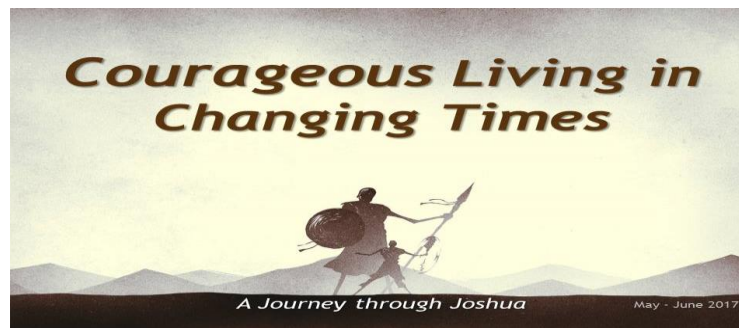
MEMBERSHIP EXPECTATIONS
