Our Constitution specifies the following qualifications for a Deacon at Lancaster Baptist Church:

Deacon candidates must be regular attendees and should have attended at least 50% of the Sunday services. The only exceptions would be for family crisis or work schedule. Deacon candidates must be at least 21 years of age.
