DEACON SELECTION

Our Constitution specifies the following qualifications for a Deacon at Lancaster Baptist Church:

Deacon candidates must be a member of the church, one year prior to being eligible for election. Deacon candidates cannot have been divorced. Deacon candidates must be regular attendees and should have attended at least 50% of the Sunday services. The only exceptions would be for family crisis or work schedule. Deacon candidates must be at least 21 years of age.
