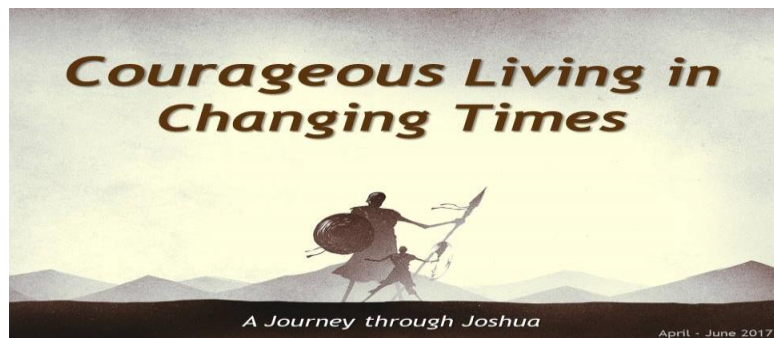
MEMBERSHIP EXPECTATIONS
