**From Your Pastor** *The Future of the Southern Baptist Convention*

Next week I will go to St. Louis for the 2016 SBC Annual Meeting. I always enjoy the Pastor's Conference on Sunday evening and Monday as some of the best preachers in the world are invited to preach. The SBC convention was a little different last year as all of Tuesday evening was devoted to a prayer meeting. I was encouraged to see a call to prayer on the schedule again this year (on Tuesday evening). I don't know if there is anything more important for pastors/church members to do as a convention than to pray and ask God for spiritual awakening and revival. I want us (Southern Baptist) to be a people of prayer and great reliance upon Almighty God.

Ronnie Frames has served as the SBC President the past couple of years and has worked tirelessly to call us to prayer and revival. He sent a message this week about what he envisions for the future of the Southern Baptist Convention. He mentions seven things and I agree with all of them.

- 1. A Bible-believing Southern Baptist Convention** (believing the Bible is infallible, trustworthy, sufficient, and inerrant, progressing us toward the goal set before us).
- 2. A Gospel-advancing Southern Baptist Convention** (one passion that keeps us united is *advancing the gospel of Jesus Christ to the entire nation and world*).
- 3. A Leader-developing Southern Baptist Convention** (every member in the body of Christ must be developed to do the work of the ministry in and through the local church).
- 4. A Multi-ethnic, Multi-lingual Southern Baptist Convention** (each church must become committed to reach people that comprise their community, including those of unique ethnicity).
- 5. A Local Church-centered Southern Baptist Convention** (we are not centered on our SBC national entities, state conventions, or regional associations; we are to be centered on local churches).
- 6. A Generously-giving Southern Baptist Convention** (we are able to go so much through the Cooperative Program because of the generosity of our people).
- 7. A People-loving Southern Baptist Convention** (Southern Baptists should want to be known for being a people-loving convention, both within our family and outside of our family. Jesus calls us to love one another.)

While other denominations are arguing over whether or not to ordain homosexuals and permit homosexual unions, I am glad that Southern Baptist are united around the great need to reach the people and nations with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Please pray that these meetings will encourage pastors and churches in regards to the Great Commission, prayer, and seeking God for a nationwide and global awakening. There has never been a greater urgency for the churches to shine the light of Christ in the midst of such darkness. I look forward to seeing what God wants to accomplish in and through Southern Baptist next week and for months to come. May God be glorified in His churches!
