From Your Pastor

Men Stepping Up

Be alert, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong. Let all that you do be done in love. 1Corinthians 16:13-14



Sunday night we took a little time to recognize and celebrate some of the ways that God is moving in the lives of our men. For several years our Men's ministry seemed to be stalled. We've prayed that God would begin a new work in the lives of our men and it was a blessed service as we recognized that God was answering our prayers. Last year a number of our men went through a study called "Act Like Men" based off of 1 Corinthians 16:13-14 (above). This year we have been going through a study by Dennis Rainey called "Stepping Up: A Call to Courageous Manhood."

In this study, Rainey has talked about the courage it takes to be a man and the need to reject the passivity of men in our culture. The study considered the various stages of life, from boyhood to patriarch. Boys need a father figure in their lives. We talked about the battle of moving from adolescence to manhood and how many men try to stay too long in adolescence. We talked about stepping up as men (again and again and again) and leading our families. We talked about mentoring and investing in other generations. Men need other men in their lives. Dietrich Bonhoeffer said, "It is the righteous man who lives for the next generation." Finally, we talked about the need for patriarchs and how the final stage of life for men can be a time of both influence and relevance.

We recognized that the Lord has blessed us with some godly older men who can serve as patriarchs for our younger men. Those men need to be invited to speak into our lives. Our older men were encouraged to finish well and not quit on their final lap. As men journey from boyhood to manhood, mentors and patriarchs can be invaluable. We heard two awesome testimonies on Sunday evening. Craig shared how his marriage had been saved by men coming alongside of him and holding him accountable. Ron shared about how he had become convicted about some things he hadn't shared with his son and some things he wants to share with his grandson.

We recognize that we have some men who are eager to grow in godliness. They are getting together, studying the Word, praying for one another, and holding one another accountable. It is exciting to see God raising up men at LBC. I hope you will pray for our men and speak words of encouragement to them as they strive to step up and lead with courage and relevance.
