From Your Pastor

Culture of Evangelism

This past Sunday we talked about having a culture of evangelism. Some of the necessities were to be motivated by a love for Jesus, fueled by a care for souls, confidence in the Gospel, and everyone engaged in evangelism. We also talked about celebrating evangelism and conversions. I want us to be a church where evangelistic attempts are celebrated. Evangelism doesn't always lead to conversion but it is obedience to God's Great Commission and brings glory to God. I know some people are fearful of evangelism so we want to help equip our folks and send them out with others who are more confident in sharing. In 2 Timothy 2:2, Paul instructed Timothy and encouraged him to pass along what he had learned to other faithful men who can teach others. That is a good way to equip members in evangelism—watch others and then teach others.

So, if you have the opportunity to share the gospel or have some discussions about the Lord with your friends, relatives, associates, or neighbors, I would love to hear about your evangelism. I think we can encourage one another by being intentional in the area of evangelism. We met last night to talk about some areas where we can improve our evangelism as a church. We are going to do some evangelism testimonies, schedule some times for prayer walks, schedule some evangelistic events, target parents of our KidZRock that are unchurched, get our SS teachers involved in evangelism, and try to get 44 involved in two 6-week semesters of Reach this Fall. We will also have a Fall revival in September this year (Sept. 11-14).

Evangelism can be a little risky in the sense that we are confronting the culture around us. If we are concerned about souls and believe in the reality of hell for those without Christ, we can't worry about what everybody thinks about us. We may get sneered or rejected but that is ok. Jesus was rejected and we should expect to be as well.

We know that the local church is God's revealed method of evangelism. We are to live out the gospel and we are to share/tell the gospel every time we have an opportunity. There is nothing more exciting and refreshing to share the gospel and even more so when they respond in repentance and faith in Jesus Christ. Let's go to battle for the sake of lost souls. Let's do the work of evangelist! **Bro Harold**
