From Your Pastor *Making Prayer a Priority*

I think most Christians would acknowledge that prayer is important. However, we often fail to make prayer a priority in our daily lives. Since the beginning of the year I have really felt burdened to pray for a spiritual awakening in our land and in our churches. We went through a series called "Revive" in which we looked at being desperate for God's presence and devoted to prayer. Ronnie Floyd, the current president of the Southern Baptist Convention, has been encouraging Southern Baptist to pray for a revival. We even had an evening of prayer at the SBC convention.

Often I don't persevere in praying for something. Recent decisions by the Supreme Court and the downward spiral of morality in our country can cause you to lose hope and relent in fervent praying for spiritual awakening. On Sat., July 4th I went for an early walk and listened to a sermon by Adrian Rogers on the power of prayer (Acts 12). When his sermon was over I decided to listen to a sermon by Greg Laurie and it caught me off guard when he was also preaching on prayer and was looking at that same passage in Acts 12 (Peter was in prison and the church was praying). The Lord reminded me afresh that I shouldn't lose heart in praying for spiritual awakening in America.

It was a blessing to see the various Christians come out to the square on Sunday night to pray for our land. I believe that God will send revival and a spiritual awakening when we get serious about seeking Him through prayer. This week I am working on 1 Timothy 2 and Paul says, "First of all, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgiving be made for all people." Let us be a people committed to prayer. Let us ask, seek and knock until the Lord sends revival. Let's make prayer a priority! *Bro Harold*

Question 23: What is the misery into which all mankind fell through Adam's first sin?

Answer: All mankind, by their fall, lost communion with God, are under his wrath and curse, and so made liable to all the miseries of this life, to death itself, and to the pains of hell forever.

Scripture: Genesis 3:8, 24; Ephesians 2:3; Galatians 3:10; Romans :23; Matthew 25:41; Psalm 9:17

Comment: Keep in mind that "liable to" means that these miseries of this life, to death itself, and to the pains of hell forever.

Question 24: Did God leave all mankind to perish in the condition of sin and misery?

Answer: God, out of his mere good pleasure, from all eternity, having chosen a people to everlasting life, did enter into a covenant of grace, to deliver them out of the condition of salvation, by a Redeemer.
